ST. JOHNS COUNTY ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC INTERRUPTIONS *AUGUST 16, 2010 – AUGUST 22, 2010*

St. Johns County announced today that the following roads will be under construction August 16, 2010 – August 22, 2010.

NORTHEAST - (32082, 32095)

- Nocatee Parkway: general roadway construction; periodic lane closures and/or restrictions
- Ponte Vedra from Mickler to Sawgrass – periodic lane closures & underground utilities
- Ponte Vedra Boulevard & San Juan Drive from Solano Road to County line - bore & underground utility work on narrow shoulders; possible lane restrictions
- San Juan Drive and Pablo Road area off Ponte Vedra Boulevard north of Solana Road – underground cable installation with possible lane closures
- DeLeon Shores on Dolphin, Marlin, Vista Grande, Del Prado and other streets in this section - underground cable and directional bore
- Pablo Bridge replacement between San Juan and Ponte Vedra Boulevard until approximately March 1, 2011. Detour around this construction will be in place on Miranda & San Juan Drive
- Valley Ridge from Palm Valley Bridge past 20 Mile Road – delays due to movement of heavy equipment
- Old Lewis Speedway – periodic lane closures/ditch maintenance

NORTHWEST – (32259, 32092)

- CR 210 at St. Johns Forest - right lane closure and utility work
- US 1 at Race Track Road – periodic lane closures, utilities & road construction
- Race Track Road – milling, resurfacing and periodic lane closures
- CR 210 from Russell Sampson Road to Sandy Creek – periodic lane closures, pavement replacement, and underground utility installation
- N. Bartram Trail – repairing inlet box with periodic temporary lane closures
- CR 210 – periodic east and west bound lane closures between Leo Maguire Parkway and South Hampton
- CR 208 – shoulder closure for headwall and pipe replacement near 4001 CR 208
- CR 13N near CR 208 - box culvert extensions with possible lane closures

- CR 210 W from CR 16A to Greenbriar Road – periodic lane closures
- Lee Road – periodic lane closures & ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th
- Sheffield Road – periodic lane closures & ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th
- Janet Drive – periodic lane closures & ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th
- Marlee Road – periodic lane closures & ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th

CENTRAL – (32084)

- West Positano Avenue – underground utility installation
- Rolling Hills Drive at SR 207 – intersection improvements
- SR 207 @ SR 312 – utility relocations and lane restrictions

SOUTHEAST – (32086, 32080)

- Kings Road from Oakbrook to Wellington Court – possible lane closures
- Old Moultrie Road between Lewis Point Rd and Hideaway Lake Drive – lane restrictions and paving operations
- A Street, 11th Street and 16th Street - sanitary sewer installation with periodic disruptions
- Shore Drive @ Dorado Drive – pipe replacements requiring periodic lane closures
- A Street and 11th Street - sidewalk replacement and wheelchair warning devices installation
- Oak Street at 16th Street – open but temporarily unpaved
- A Street @ 4th Street – uneven road surface
- Datil Pepper Road – periodic lane closures & ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th

SOUTHWEST – (32033, 32145)

- CR 13 A S between CR 214 & CR 305 – periodic lane closures & shoulder work and ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th
- CR 214 from Travis Lane to CR 13 N – possible lane closures due to road milling and resurfacing, road widening and drainage work
- CR 13 A S between CR 214 & CR 305 – periodic lane closures & shoulder work and ditch/swale maintenance: Monday, August 16th – Thursday, August 19th

Construction signs, barricades and barriers will be used as necessary to direct motorists through and around work areas. Motorists should use caution and may experience delays. Citizens are encouraged to use alternate routes to avoid construction areas.
