Commission selects names for new County Roads

St. Augustine, FL – (May 31, 2007) – The St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners selected names for three new county roads on Tuesday. County Road 2209 becomes St Johns Parkway, County Road 244 is now Longleaf Pine Parkway and County Road 223 becomes Veterans Parkway.

St Johns Parkway came as a suggestion from District 1 Commissioner Cyndi Stevenson. The Board selected the other two names from a list prepared by a road naming task force.

St Johns Parkway is the largest road St. Johns County has been required to construct, running from Race Track Road in the northwest down to County Road 208 in the south. The northernmost portion of St Johns Parkway between Race Track Road and Russell Sampson Road is currently open. Longleaf Pine Parkway, upon completion, will extend from St Johns Parkway in the northwest to the intersection of County Roads 210 and 16A in the World Golf Village area. The first section of Longleaf Pine Parkway between St Johns Parkway and Greenbriar Road opened last week. Veterans Parkway, which also opened last week, is complete and runs
